To My Beloved Church Family,

May God bless you for your continued commitment to walk with me on this spiritual journey, leading by example when the path is unclear, when problems slow me down and I seek the Lord for guidance. These are challenging times, but with God it will come to pass.

After having conversation with our Deacon Ministry Interim Chair, Deacon Edwin Moore and most definitely understanding the reservations to distribute communion on Saturday, April 4th, a humble and reverent decision has been made to cancel the Saturday communion distribution.

Let me share the alternative solution for communion as one family in Christ.

Please consider having something prepared from your home; choose crackers, bread, wafers to represent the body of Christ; likewise, consider water, juice, wine or any beverage to represent the blood for Christ.

Take a picture of your communion and send it to the Pastor, if possible. Yes, I am up to something.

At the conclusion of the service, we will read our covenant in the comfort of our homes. A copy of the covenant will be emailed to you.

We will pray over all communion.

We will commune together.
